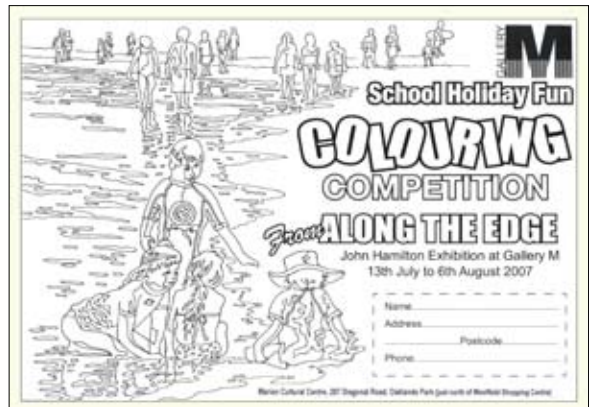
**FOR THE WOOD TURNERS**
