## SAD NEWS

Former Mayor of Marion Colin Haines passed away peacefully in his sleep on Friday 21 August.

Colin served the City of Marion for 18 years. Beginning as a Councillor in 1982, he was Alderman from 1985 - 1991 before becoming the city's longest serving Mayor from 1991 - 2000. He also served as a member of the State Executive of the Local Government Association from 1994 - 1996.

Colin was the driving force behind the development of the Marion Cultural Centre and the Living Kaurna Cultural Centre. His enthusiasm for promoting arts and culture was reflected in his support of the Red House Group. He was Chairperson of the RHG Board from 1998 - 2003. He was also a Friend of Gallery M.

Colin was a passionate supporter of the Sister Cities relationship with the Japanese city of Kokobunji and was a regular visitor to Japan. He was also a member of the international organisation, Mayors for Peace.

His approachable and friendly nature ensured that he was popular with council staff and the many community groups he worked with.

Colin continued to contribute to the City of Marion after he left council by serving as a member of the Abbeyfield board, co-patron of Suneden Special School and Galleon Theatre.
