The Blake Prize exhibition concludes this Friday 31 July - thanks to everyone who assisted with extra duties to help make it a success. We will be packing up this weekend 1 & 2 August - please advise if you are able once again to chip in and help prepare the art for transportation (it's being collected Monday).

The next exhibition is the whole gallery Red House exhibition 'RH-09'. If you have put in an entry, your Consignment Agreement and art label is in this mail-out. Delivery day is Tuesday 4 August from 10-4pm. If you can't come that day, you must arrange to deliver it prior to Tuesday. Late deliveries cannot be accepted.

We also have a lot of spare invitations for this exhibition, so if you can help distribute them through your networks, please collect a bundle when you bring in your artwork.

You will also see that all shop commission is now 22% (see enclosed flyer). We are looking for new work and new artists, so spread the word that we now have one low commission with no obligation to volunteer on a regular basis.

Due to lower than hoped for sales, and the high cost of printing the 2009 calendar, we are not doing a calendar for 2010. Selected images from the 'RH-09' exhibition may be featured on cards as a fund raising exercise - you will be contacted to provide complete consent (optional) if your artwork is chosen.
