### IN MEMORIAM - Jose Telleria

Jose Telleria, one of our original Red House members, sadly passed away in Flinders Medical Centre on 28 October, after a heart attack several weeks before. He was 80 years old. Jose was much loved by everyone here at Gallery M, and always had a big smile and a warm hug for all his friends. He was a talented wood carver, and many of you know his quirky hand carved doorknockers, wall plaques and sculptural artworks that he often exhibited in Red House exhibitions. His home on Diagonal Road is very recognisable with a front yard full of his wonderful carved totems and other artworks.

Jose was born in the Basque Province of northern Spain. His native tongue was Basque, but he spoke fluent Spanish, Italian and English. His studies in his home town of Lekeitio included music, free hand drawing and some architecture.

He first became interested in Basque art, both painting and wood carving at a very young age. His other interests were amateur bike riding through the Pyrenees, playing guitar plus traditional Basque instruments.

Jose came to Australia in 1955, and worked as a cane cutter in Queensland. From there he moved to Darwin, and was the first Spaniard to be nationalized in the Northern Territory. He moved to Coober Pedy, and spent sixteen years opal mining. He also married there, and has two children who are now married.

In his retirement he enjoyed voluntary work, and his art and music. In the early days of the old Red House Gallery, Jose was the weekend Duty Manager, assisting the weekend volunteers by opening and closing the gallery, and looking after the weekend takings. He was always available to lend a helping hand, especially with his handyman skills. He could fix anything!

Jose worked with the City of Marion as a volunteer, on their graffiti removal team. He also decorated several bus shelters in the Marion area.

Our sympathy goes to Jose's family. He will be sadly missed by all his friends from the Red House Group.
