Many of our long time members will remember Carl Van Nieuwmans, who sadly passed away in May this year. Carl was a talented artist who moved to Adelaide in 1981, after migrating to Australia from his native Holland.

Carl became involved with the core group of Foundation Red House Group members, and helped to establish the old Red House Gallery in 1994. It was through this association that he met his wife Lee Sanders, and they married in 1995.

Lee introduced Carl to porcelain art, and they set up a business providing supplies to porcelain artists.

Lee continues to be a valued member of the Red House Group, and her beautifully decorated porcelain is on display in the Gallery M shop.
