SAD NEWS

Many of you will be saddened to hear of the sudden and tragic death of former Red House member Rachel Fawkes, who passed away on New Years Day 2010. Rachel joined the Red House Group in 2003, after arriving in Adelaide from Scotland in 2001.

Rachel was a fibre and textile artist, creating exquisite machine stitched layered images combining fabric and paper. She exhibited with the Wild Fibres artists and in other exhibitions, and was a volunteer at Gallery M.

Rachel was well known in the Brighton area where she worked in various Jetty Road cafes and at Adelaide Stained Glass Studio.

2009 was an exciting year for her. She moved to the USA where she got married, and had a baby daughter (whom she named Adelaide) on Xmas Eve. It was a beautiful happy time for her, but she died suddenly at her home in Los Angeles, only a week later.
